This is not the season to step back, but rather a time to arise, in our personal and corporate times of ASKing.

In the introduction to the July/August ASKing Point, we were reminded of "incredible opportunities to gather, to ASK with the Word, to ASK in agreement, to ASK in power."

One of ASK's foundational scriptures is from John 2:5 - "Do whatever He tells you." Thinking about the incredible opportunities to join others in ASKing with the Word and seeking to be obedient to "do whatever He tells you," we are writing to let you know of a shift in the format of our National Prayer Call.

Knowing the increasing need to not only ASK for the nations of the world, but to also provide a dedicated time of ASKing for our own nation, *beginning in August*, we will expand the time of our monthly National Prayer Call (via ZOOM) from 1 hour to 1-1/2 hours. We will continue to focus the first 30 minutes on one of the nations highlighted in the ASKing Point, with the remaining hour focused on prayer specifically for the USA.

We are also exploring options for other dedicated times to ASK with the Word for the USA...more to follow.
